Slippery Rock University invites applications for the position of Director and Chief of University Police. The University is seeking a leader with vision and a commitment to excellence. This individual must be able to effectively direct police operations while assuring the integration of police work into the fabric of an institution of higher education.

Qualifications: Bachelors degree in Criminal justice, police administration or other related field required. Master's degree preferred. Successful performance in an on-campus interview is required. Required to be Act 120 certified with all MPOETC updates complete prior to employment at SRU, and be able to obtain commissioning as a Slippery Rock University Police officer within six months of employment at SRU. Strong communication and leadership and supervisory skills with the demonstrated ability to build positive working and community relationships are also required. A minimum of seven years experience as a full-time commissioned law enforcement officer, with five years of law enforcement supervisory responsibilities, which must include experience which goes beyond shift supervisory work is required. Experience as a law enforcement officer at an institution of higher education, or on a municipal police force working directly with an institution of higher education police force on a daily basis; Poles and Posit certification; administrative skills; excellent written and oral communication skills; public speaking skills, personal history of community policing; emergency operations experience; federal and state crime report preparation; and budget preparation experience are preferred.
