## **DIRECTOR OFFICE OF PUBLIC SAFETY - ITHACA COLLEGE**

Ithaca College invites applications for the position of Director of Public Safety. This vital position is responsible for the direction, coordination, and administration of the activities and services of the Office of Public Safety. The Director will oversee patrol and security services, environmental health and safety, and parking and traffic services; promote and ensure the safety and security of College students, personnel, and property; ensure enforcement of all applicable College regulations, criminal codes, and government safety requirements; and develop policies and procedures governing all campus safety operations. The successful candidate will also develop and submit a comprehensive departmental budget, oversee emergency management and the investigation of major campus incidents, and serve as the interface with local, state, and federal law enforcement agencies. This position reports to the Associate Vice President of Student Affairs & Campus Life and has primary responsibility for the direction and supervision of all personnel within the Office of Public Safety.

**Qualifications:** Bachelor's degree and a minimum of 8 years relevant experience in law enforcement required. Proven supervisory and management experience; demonstrated ability to effectively direct, plan, and administer a comprehensive, community-oriented policing agency or division; emergency management experience; excellent organizational, interpersonal, written and verbal communication skills; and a valid driver's license also required. Previous experience working in a college or university setting and an understanding of law enforcement issues specific to colleges and universities strongly preferred.
