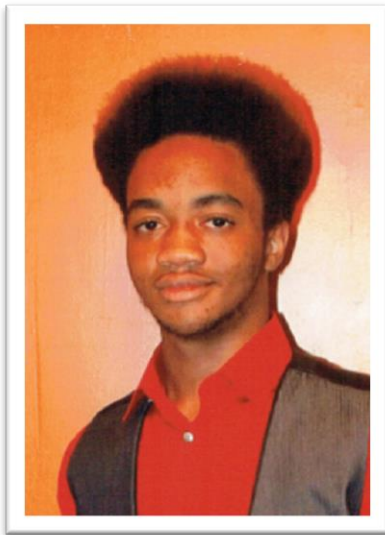


Issiah Talton

Myles is the son of Theodore and Paulette Johnson.

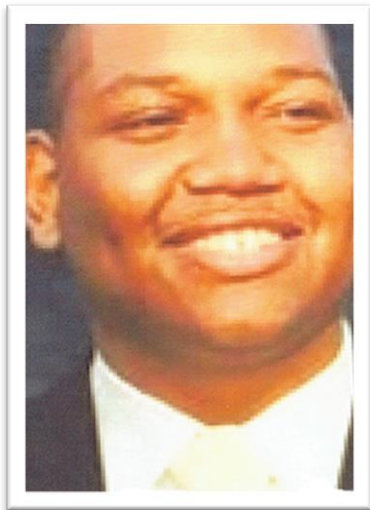


Jessica Marie Singletary

A'Lexus is the daughter of Alexander Monsanto and Jeanetha Harrison.

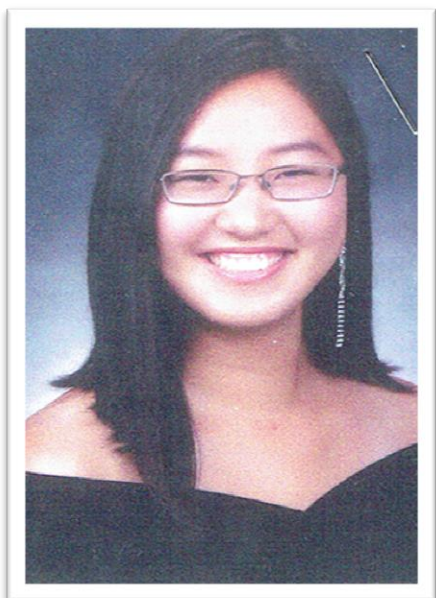


Dallas Davetta Davis

Enkhjin is the daughter of Bayarma Columbia and Batbuyan Dorjpalam.

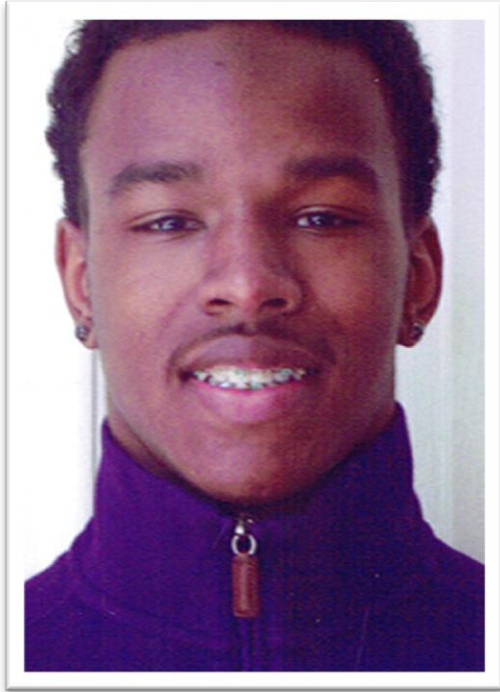


Jese'nia Jackson
